

> Baseball Alberta Provincial League Pitch Count rules shall apply.

o It is the responsibility of each team to check the pitching charts and score sheets for accuracy.

> A courtesy runner is permitted for the catcher when there are two (2) outs for all levels of play.

 \succ The length of games for:

o Round robin or other designated games shall be a maximum of seven (7) innings [six (6) for 11U].

o A new inning must not start after 2 hours (120 minutes)

• Championship games shall be seven (7) innings [six (6) for 11U] or until a winner is declared.

• There is no time limit.

• Mercy Rule is in effect 10 or more runs when the losing team has completed their 5th offensive inning/at bat (4th for the 11U AA Division).

- Points in round robin games are awarded in the following manner:
 - Win = 2 points
 - Loss = 0 points

o If a game is tied at the end of the final inning (last inning after the time limit or after the last inning), one more inning will be played. For this inning, the batting team will start with runners at 1st and 2nd with no outs.

> For determining the team standings, In the event of a tie, the following will apply:

o If two (2) teams are tied, the result of the game between the two teams will determine who will advance.

o If three (3) teams are tied, if one team has beaten the other two then that team will advance.

- o If the above is not the case, then the following will decide:
 - Runs against in all round robin games.
 - If still tied runs for in all round robin games
 - If still tied -coin toss
- ➤ Tournament Conduct:

o Coaches & Managers are responsible for the behavior & conduct of players, team officials & team supporters at all times both on & off the field.

o Abuse of officials, players, coaches and/or spectators will not be tolerated.

o If a coach, manager or player is ejected from two (2) games, he/she will no longer be able to participate in the Tournament.

o Gross misconduct from any player or coach will result in ejection from the Tournament. Each case will be decided by the Tournament Committee.
